Overview

HHS, HRSA and the Department of Defense (DOD) have partnered to provide rapid COVID-19 point of care (POC) tests and analyzers ("rapid POC systems") to HRSA Health Center Program awardees and Health Center Program look-alikes ("health centers"). A single system consists of a hand-held analyzer (equipment that reads the results) and a test kit (supplies for 30 tests).

Rapid POC systems will be shipped to each health center's administrative address on record in the HRSA Electronic Handbooks (EHB). Health Centers are expected to distribute the systems (analyzers and test kits) to permit their use at the range of in scope service site locations, to the extent applicable.
