BE IT MOVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS, That the City Planning Commission is directed to conduct a public hearing to consider amending and re-ordaining the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance (Ordinance No. M.C.S. 4264, as amended by Ordinance No. 26,413 M.C.S. and subsequent amendments) to create a new use category of “convenience centers,” or “waste and recycling drop-off centers” to consider the addition of such to use tables in all appropriate zoning districts, to establish site design and use standards, and to make recommendations for any other amendments deemed necessary. In the course of review, CPC should study regulations in similarly situated municipalities, as well as applicable State regulations, to guide potential amendments.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS, That in the process of studying and reviewing the proposed request, the City Planning Commission staff is directed and granted the flexibility to make all appropriate changes relative to this request to ensure consistency and continuity and to make needed and/or appropriate adjustments deemed necessary stemming from the study and review of this request.
