State Aid – Decreasing by \$122,500 due to project completion and \$2,980,537 due to not using
parent codes to hold these funds anymore.
CD Year 26 – decreases by \$249,750
Hazard Mitigation Grant Program – decreases by \$785,582 for cancelled projects.
