AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Sections 58-36, 106-136, 142-38, 154-882, 154-1191, 154-1195 (a) and (b), 154-1202, and 154-1561 to change references therein from Jefferson Davis Parkway or Jeff Davis Parkway to Norman C. Francis Parkway or to Moss Street in accordance with Ordinance No. 28,444 MCS; and otherwise to provide with respect thereto.

SECTION 1. THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS HEREBY ORDAINS,

That Section 58-36 of the Code of the City of New Orleans is hereby amended and reordained to read as follows:

“Sec. 58-36. - Establishment of Precincts.

The election precincts of the city under R.S. 18:532, are as follows:

THIRD WARD

Ward 3/Precinct 8: Bounded by the centerline of Interstate 10, to the centerline of South Norman C. Francis Parkway, to the centerline of Tulane Avenue, to the centerline of South Broad Street, to the centerline of Canal Street, to the centerline of South Claiborne Avenue, back to the centerline of Interstate 10. (Editorial note: Formerly Ward 3, Precinct 3, Ward 3, Precinct 5, and Ward 3, Precinct 8.)

Ward 3/Precinct 12: Bounded by the centerline of Tulane Avenue, to the centerline of South Norman C. Francis Parkway, to the centerline of Interstate 10, to the centerline of South Telemachus Street, to the centerline of Canal Street, to the centerline of South Salcedo Street, back to the

centerline of Tulane Avenue. (Editorial note: Formerly Ward 3/Precinct 10 and Ward 3/Precinct 12.)

FIFTH WARD

Ward 5/Precinct 12: Bounded by the centerline of Bayou St. John, to the centerline of North Norman C. Francis Parkway, to the centerline of St. Louis Street, to the centerline of North Carrollton Avenue, to the centerline of Dumaine Street, back to the centerline of Bayou St. John.”

SECTION 2. That Section 106-136 of the Code of the City of New Orleans is hereby amended and reordained to read as follows:

“Sec. 106-136. – Commission to carry on functions of certain former organizations.

The New Orleans Recreation Development Commission (formerly the New Orleans Recreation Department) shall operate the recreational programs formerly carried on by the Junior Sports Association Commission, the Supervisor of Lawrence Square, the Public Bath Commission, the Teen-Age Clubs, including the installation on South Norman C. Francis Parkway near Perdido Street, and the former recreational activities of the former office of the Commissioner of Public Property and shall exercise all powers, duties and responsibilities heretofore granted to such agencies. The New Orleans Recreation Development Commission shall likewise operate the playground recreational program formerly carried on by the Playground and Community Service Commission.”

SECTION 3. That Section 142-38 of the Code of the City of New Orleans is hereby amended and reordained to read as follows:

“Sec. 142-38. - Cultural Arts Districts.

The following shall be the cultural districts of the city:

(18) The "South Broad Street Cultural District" generally surrounded by the following boundaries:

The western boundary: The eastern side of Napoleon Avenue from North Miro Street to South Broad Street, then South Dupre Street from South Broad Street to Eden Street, to South Gayoso Street to Eve Street to South Rendon Street to Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard to South Norman C. Francis Parkway to Erato Street to South Clark Street to Clio Street to South Genois Street to Palm Street to Broadway Street to Drexel Street to South Carrollton Avenue to Interstate 10."

(21) The "Uptown-University Cultural District" generally surrounded by the following boundaries:

The northern boundary: The northern side of Stroelitz Street, from the western side of Dublin Street to the western side of Fern Street; the western side of Fern Street, from the northern side of Stroelitz Street to the northern side of Washington Avenue; the northern side of Washington Avenue, from the western side of Fern Street to the eastern side of Pine Street; the eastern side of Pine Street, from the northern side of Washington Avenue to the northern side of Edinburgh Street; the northern side of Edinburgh Street, from the eastern side of Pine Street to the eastern side of S. Telemachus Street; the eastern side of S. Telemachus Street, from the northern side of Edinburgh Street to the northern side of Erato Street; the northern side of Erato Street, from the eastern side of S. Telemachus Street to the eastern side of S. Genois Street; the eastern side of S. Genois Street, from the northern side of Erato Street to the northern side of Thalia Street; the northern side of Thalia Street, from the eastern side of S. Genois Street to the eastern side of S. Clark Street; the eastern side of S. Clark Street, from the northern side of Thalia Street to the northern side of Dart Street; the northern side of Dart Street to the eastern side of South Norman C. Francis Parkway; the eastern side of South

31 Norman C. Francis Parkway, from the northern side of Eve Street to the northern side of Eden
32 Street; the northern side of Eden Street, from the eastern side of South Norman C. Francis Parkway
33 to the eastern side of S. Salcedo Street; the eastern side of S. Salcedo Street, from the northern side
34 of Eden Street to the northern side of Elba Street; the northern side of Elba Street, from the eastern
35 side of S. Salcedo Street to the eastern side of S. Gayoso Street; the eastern side of S. Gayoso Street,
36 from the northern side of Elba Street to the western side of Napoleon Avenue.

1 **SECTION 4.** That Section 154-882 of the Code of the City of New Orleans is hereby amended
2 and reordained to read as follows:

4 **"Sec. 154-882. - Median/angular parking.**

5 ***

6 (e) The neutral ground area of Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard between South Norman C.
7 Francis Parkway and South Rendon Street shall be converted into median/angular parking.
8 Construction specifications of this parking area shall be according to the approval of the
9 department of public works. The city planning commission staff and the parks and parkways
10 department shall approve the landscaping of this area. The parking area shall be signed for
11 use by the employees and the general public using the services of Total Community Action,
12 Inc."

1 **SECTION 5.** That Section 154-1191 of the Code of the City of New Orleans is hereby amended
2 and reordained to read as follows:

3 **"Sec. 154-1191. - Schedule I. One-way streets.**

4 In accordance with section 154-602 and when properly sign posted, traffic shall move only in the
5 direction indicated upon the following streets:

Clio St.	Audubon Ct.	Norman C. Francis Pkwy.	River
Clio St.	Freret St.	Camp St.	East (river)

Erato St.	Norman C. Francis Pkwy.	Audubon Ct.	Lake
Erato St.	St. Peter St.	S. Claiborne Ave.	West (lake)

SECTION 6. That Section 154-1195 of the Code of the City of New Orleans is hereby amended

and reordained to read as follows:

“Sec. 154-1195. - Schedule IV. Parking prohibited at all times on certain streets.

(a) When signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall at any time park a vehicle upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets:

Street	From	To	Side

Dixon St.	Carrollton Ave.	Dublin St.	Both sides
Dixon St.	S. Genois St.	S. Clark St.	North (downtown)
Dixon St.	S. Norman C. Francis Pkwy.	S. Clark St.	North (downtown)

Euphrosine St.	S. Broad St. Svs Rdwy.	S. White St.	North (down)
Euphrosine St.	S. Lopez St.	S. Norman C. Francis Pkwy.	North (downtown)

(b) Service vehicles shall be permitted to make deliveries during the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Parking for service vehicles will be restricted to the areas signed.

Palmetto St.	S. Norman C. Francis Pkwy.	S. Genois St.	North (downtown)

SECTION 7. That Section 154-1202 of the Code of the City of New Orleans is hereby amended and reordained to read as follows:

"Sec. 154-1202. - Schedule XI. Parking prohibited during certain hours on certain streets.

When signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle during the hours and days specified upon any of the streets below, as follows:

(14) Parking prohibited from 12:01 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. on the third Tuesday of each calendar month:

Street	From	To	Side

Norman C. Francis Pkwy.	Lafitte	Walmsley	Both sides
Moss St.	Orleans	Lafitte	Both sides

SECTION 8. That Section 154-1561 of the Code of the City of New Orleans is hereby amended and reordained to read as follows:

"Sec. 154-1561. - Designation.

(a) No motor truck, tractor or trailer whose combined weight of body and load exceeds five tons shall be permitted on any of the streets or portions of streets within the city other than

those listed herein, except that travel to or from points of destination or origin not located on one of the streets or portions of streets designated herein shall be permissible via the shortest practicable route between such point of origin or destination and the nearest street or portion of street designated herein, subject to the restrictions in section 154-1522.

N. Norman C. Francis Parkway, between Canal Street and Bienville Street.

S. Norman C. Francis Parkway, between Earhart Boulevard and Canal Street.

SECTION 9. That this ordinance shall become effective on January 1, 2021.
