WHEREAS, on March 16, 2006, the Council of the City of New Orleans, adopted Ordinance No. 22,163, M.C.S., authorizing the fourth amendment to the lease agreement between Rivergate Development Corporation, the City of New Orleans, and Jazz Casino Company, L.L.C. (successor to Harrah's Jazz Company); and

WHEREAS, said amendment included the commitment from Jazz Casino Company, L.L.C., to provide \$225,000 annually to fund the Harrah's Community Support Grants Program; and

WHEREAS, on March 21, 2013 the Council adopted Ordinance No. 25256 M.C.S., which established the City Council/Cox Communications Louisiana's Community Grant Program and among other things, established eligibility guidelines for the Program and attached an approved Grant Program Form, which contained an application form; and

WHEREAS, as noted in Ordinance No. 25256 M.C.S., the Cox Cable Franchise provides for the annual contribution of One Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$140,000.00) by Cox Communications Louisiana, LLC to community, non-profit organizations, focused upon education, technology training, communications, and similar programs benefitting the youth of the City of New Orleans; and

WHEREAS, since March 11, 2020, the City of New Orleans and the State of Louisiana have been under a declared state of emergency due to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, COVID-19 is a respiratory illness that is primarily transmitted through contact with an infected person or surface; and

WHEREAS, on May 21, 2020, the Council approved Ordinance Calendar Number 32,965 and Resolution R-20-127 establishing electronic application processes for both the Cox and Harrah's grants; and

WHEREAS, the Council believes it is in the public interest to continue to accept grant applications electronically; NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS, That the application deadline for Harrah's Community Support Grant and the City Council/Cox Communications Louisiana's Community Grant is July 1, 2021.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW ORLEANS, That all applications shall be submitted through the Council's website at council.nola.gov.
